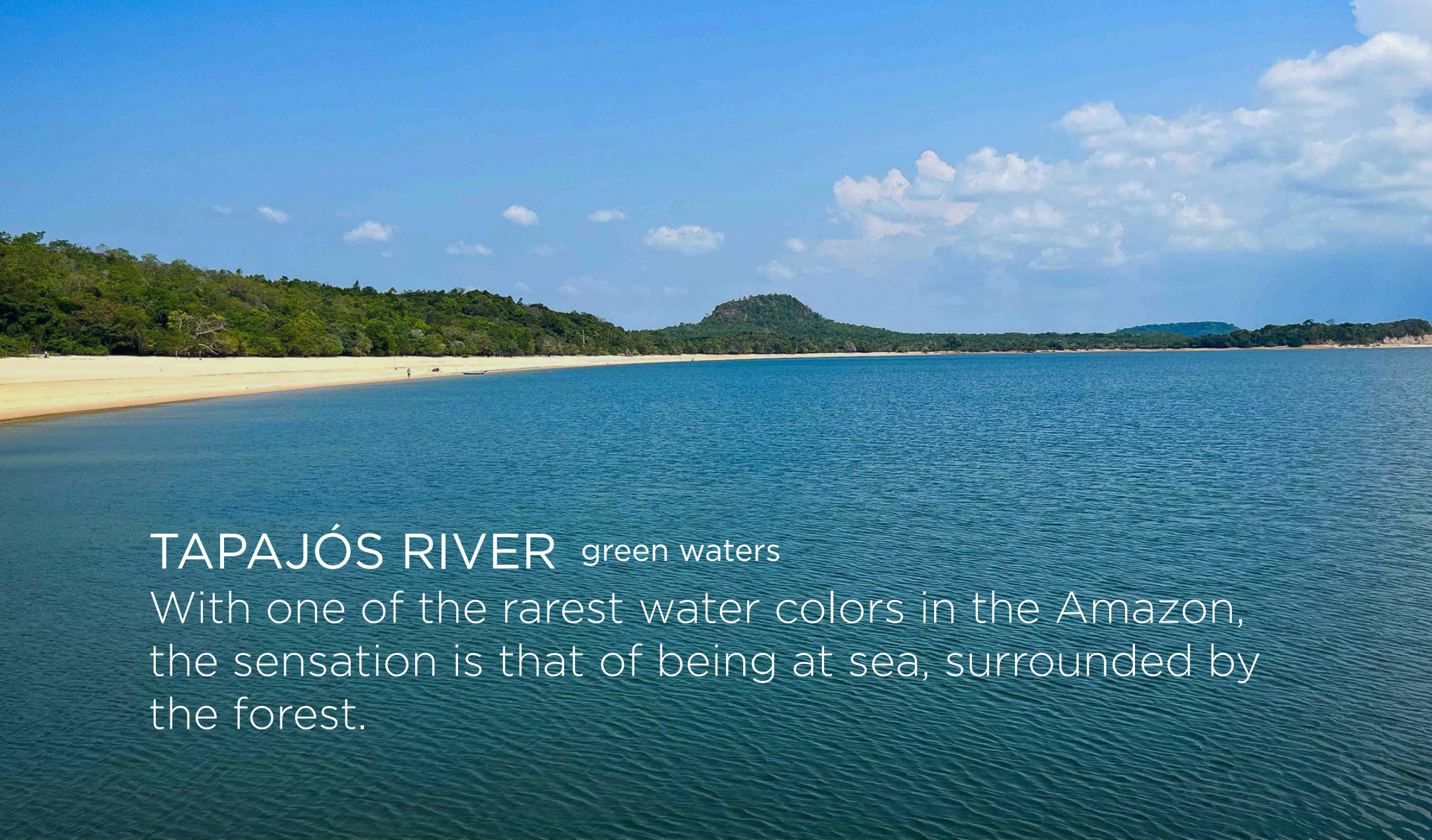

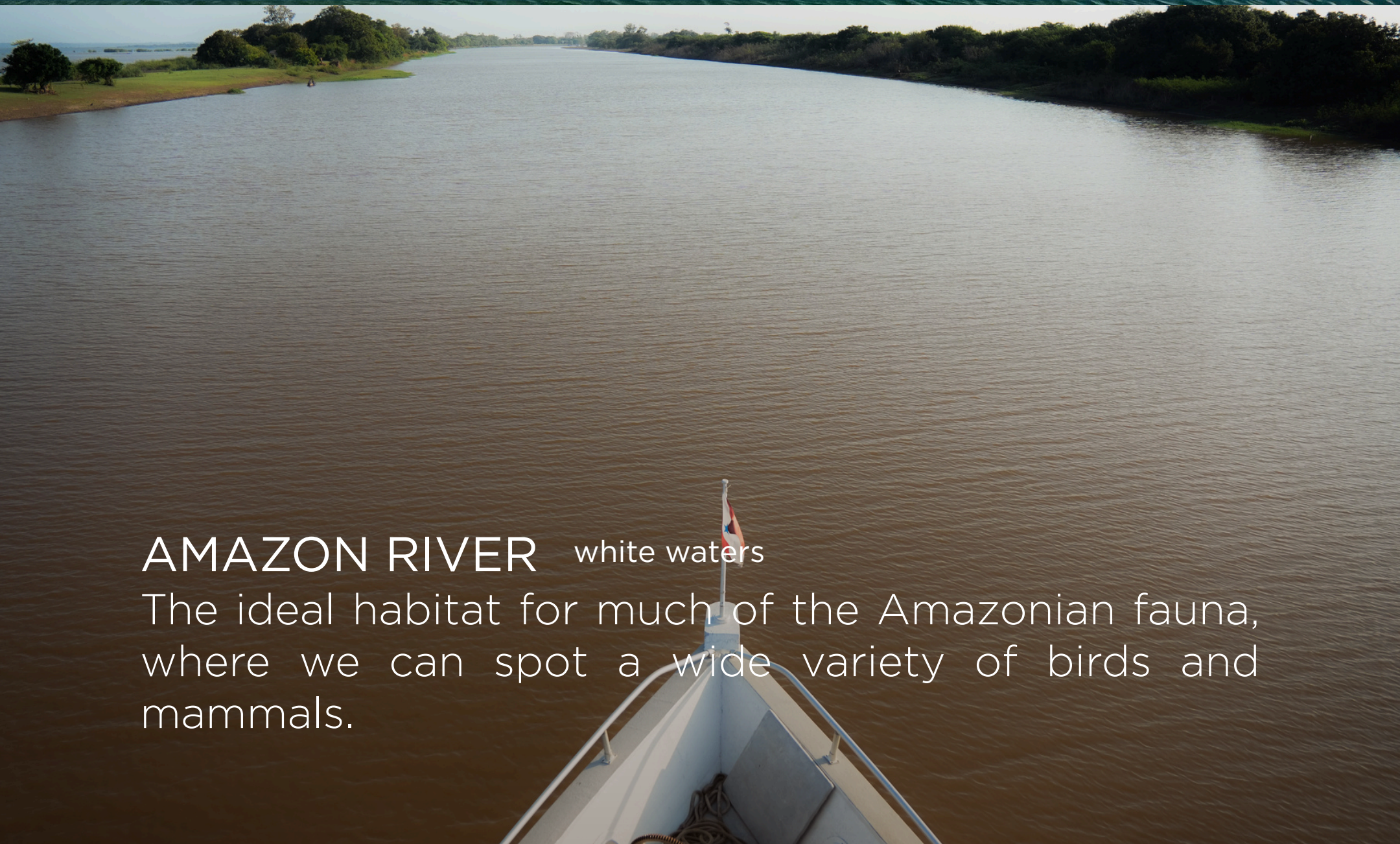

DAY 1 | A WELCOME FROM THE AMAZON




Our team will be waiting for you at the airport or at hotels in the region to take you by car to Alter do Chão, where we will depart from 12:00 PM onwards.

After settling in, being introduced to the boat and the safety procedures, you will have a baptism with your first dive in the Tapajós River. Free time for swimming.

Before boarding: if you have time, you can get to know Alter do Chão better; one of the most charming villages in the entire Amazon, which brings together good restaurants by the waterfront and around a charming central square, as well as shops selling indigenous crafts.

Boarding: from 12:00 PM to 3:00 PM.

DAY 2 | TAPAJÓS NATIONAL FOREST

After breakfast, we disembarked at the Tapajós National Forest (FLONA), one of the largest conservation units in the region, covering more than 500,000 hectares. We docked in front of the Jamaraquá community and followed a trail through the primary forest to the imposing **giant Samaúma** tree: an encounter with the essence of the Amazon and a refreshing dip in one of the most beautiful **streams** in the region. The trail can be shortened depending on the group's pace.

We returned to the boat for lunch. Free afternoon for swimming in the Tapajós River.

The best thing to do tonight is to go up to the deck to contemplate the sky, the **stars**, and the sounds of the Amazon rainforest.

DAY 3 | JARI CHANNEL AND COROCA COMMUNITY

We awake at the Jari Channel, an arm of the mighty Amazon River, to experience the Amazonian dawn; a spectacle accompanied by the symphony of birds.

We continue our journey towards the Arapiuns River, with its dark waters, lush forests, and white sand beaches. Get your camera ready: river dolphins might appear to join us.

In the late afternoon, we visited the Coroca community, with its lake, turtle nursery, and craft shop, learning from its guides about sustainable tourism in the region.

In the evening, a special dinner on board celebrates the day with authentic flavors of Pará cuisine.

DAY 4 | SÃO MARCOS COMMUNITY

Today we will enrich your Amazonian repertoire by visiting a typical **flour mill** after breakfast. We are invited by the **São Marcos** community to observe the production process of cassava derivatives — essential foods for the forest peoples.

We're back to relax and enjoy the beach. Our crew will be waiting to prepare caipirinhas with local fruits, serve traditional and irresistible snacks, or set up a hammock in the shade of a tree.

To celebrate the last night of the trip, we meticulously prepared a special dinner on the beach featuring the traditional **Piracaia**: fish grilled over charcoal.

DAY 5 | THE LAST DIVE

On the last day of the trip, we wake up in the green waters of the Tapajós River, stopping for one last farewell swim.

We return to Alter do Chão for disembarkation. Our team will then transport the group to the airport in Santarém or another preferred location in the region.

OUR RATES:

USD 3,150 per adult in a double cabin;

USD 4,350 per adult in a single cabin;

USD 2,400 for children up to 11 years old.

For a master cabin, add USD 500 per person.

Once we confirm the booking of 4 adult passengers, the trip is guaranteed. Please check the status with our customer service team.

CHILDREN:

The minimum age for children is 6 years old;

Children sharing a cabin with only one adult pay the same price as the adult.

Children traveling with 2 adults are usually accommodated in adjacent but independent cabins. For groups of 9 or more passengers, we use one of our larger boats, and in this case, there is the option of accommodating 1 child in the same room as their parents.



INCLUDED:

Ground transfers for boarding and disembarking;

4 nights' accommodation on one of our vessels;

Meals as described in the daily itinerary;

Activities and tours, including community and visitation fees;

Drinks on board: mineral water, juices, soft drinks, beers, caipirinhas, vodka, gin and tonic, whiskey;

Crew consisting of captain, sailors, cook and assistant, stewardess and hostess;

Travel insurance.

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED:

Airline tickets;

Other services in Santarém or in the village of Alter do Chão;

Optional gratuities for crew and activity guides.



PAYMENT METHOD:

Payment in installments via wire transfer:
50% down payment upon signing the contract +
50% up to 45 days before departure;

The reservation will only be confirmed upon
payment of the deposit.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

Up to 90 days before the trip, a 10% penalty will be
applied to the total amount to cover operational
expenses;

From 89 to 46 days before the trip, a 30% retention
fee will be applied to the total cost of the service.

Between 45 and 21 days before the trip, 50% of the
total service contract value will be retained;

Less than 21 days, 80% of the total service contract
value will be retained.

Cancellations of trips between December 20th and
January 10th, or during Carnival week, will incur a
100% penalty of the amounts already paid.

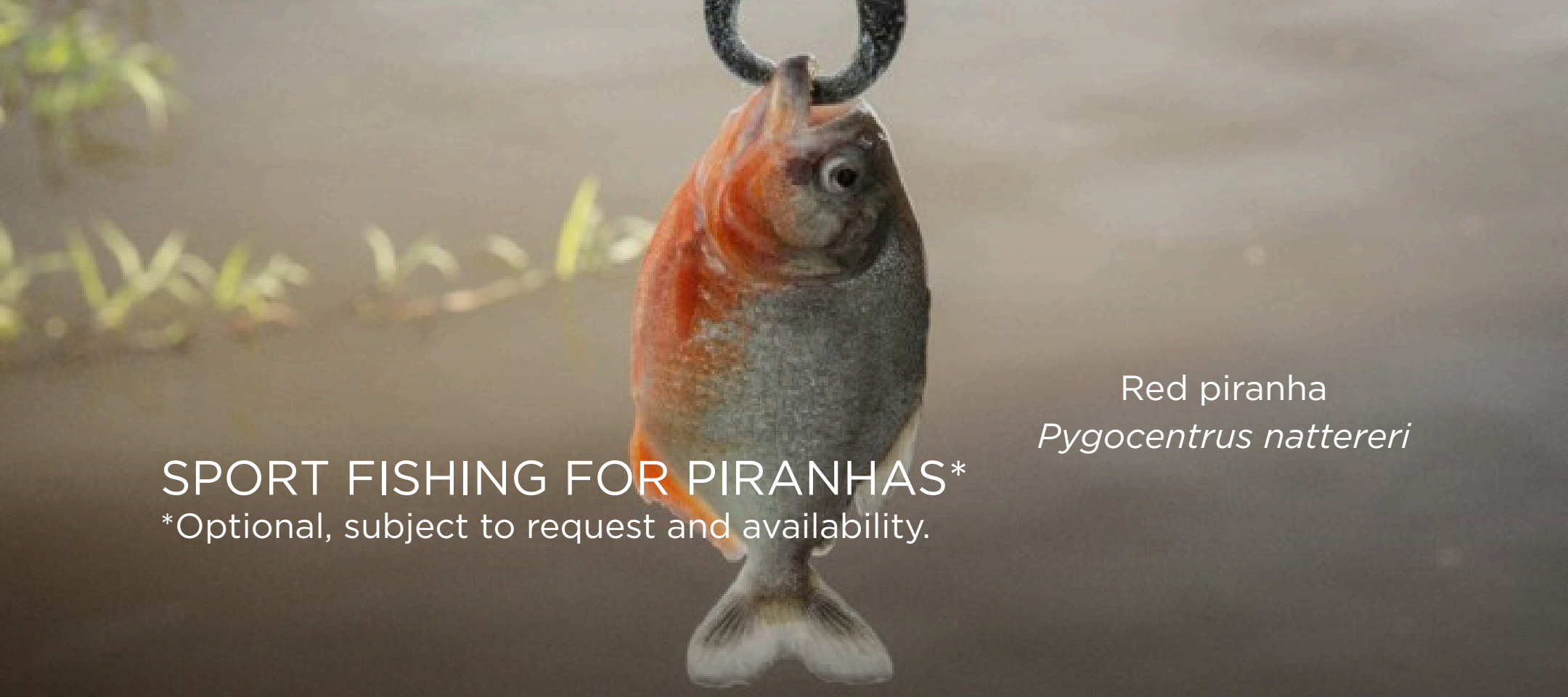

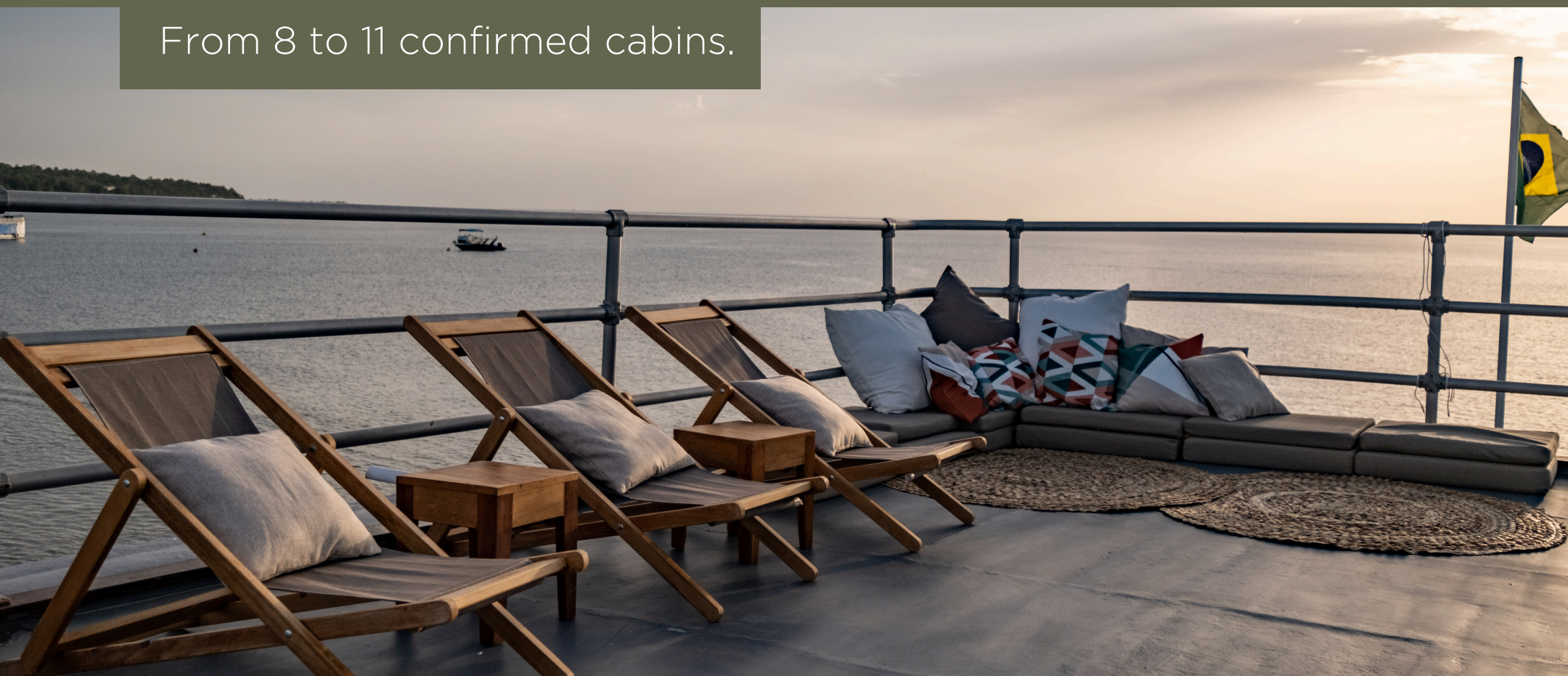

Onboard and beachside productions to provide delightful surprises.




ONBOARD SAFETY:
